

CYWC Membership Process

1 Youth worker attends Ethics in Youth Work training

- Trainings held quarterly
- Contact the office for training dates and information
- This requirement can be waived by application to the membership committee

2 Youth worker fills in a membership application

Membership pack includes a membership application, membership process and a copy of the Code of Ethics and Policies

How do I get an application??

- Application packs will be available at each Ethics in Youth Work training or
- Contact our office and we will send you one

3 Youth worker attends a membership interview

Interview dates will be held on alternative months to the Ethics in Youth Work trainings

How do I arrange an interview??

- You can book in for an interview when you attend your Ethics in Youth Work Training or
- Once your membership application has been received you will be contacted to organise an interview time or
- Contact the office to arrange a time

4 Youth worker attends a membership interview with the membership committee who will then decide if the youth worker will be accepted as a Collective member

5 If accepted, the youth worker will receive a membership contract to be signed and sent back. Once we have received the contract, a copy will be sent to the youth worker with their membership card and an invoice for membership fees

What if you're not accepted??

- You have the right to appeal to the management team, contact our office for details.

Membership Fees

Membership fees will be invoiced once a youth worker has become a member of the Collective and annually thereafter.

Individual youth worker	\$35
Agency - up to 5 youth workers	\$80
Extra youth workers	\$10
